

T4 Double Seat Swivel Base

JK Part Numbers J39381, J39388

- 1. Remove the 4 nuts securing the seat to the floor. Keep these for use in step 3.
- 2. Lift the seat off the floor studs and move it into the back of the vehicle.
- 3. Place the swivel plate on the floor studs (on the rare occasion the front drivers side locking bolt will need the seat base trimming by a few mm, It is very rare and not needed to be done on all seat bases) with the 2 corner mount bolts to the near side of the vehicle (studs may need trimming by 5mm in some situations) and take out the 2 x locating pins and 4 x security pins and turn the four locking bolts 90 degrees anti-clockwise raise up and turn 90 degrees clockwise to secure them in the raised position then secure the bottom plate down with the four nuts saved in step 1.
- 4. Re-secure the top plate and reinstall the seat.

OPERATING THE SWIVEL PLATE

Rotating the Seat to Face the Rear:

- 5. Take out the 2 x locating pins and 4 x security pins and turn the four locking bolts 90 degrees anti-clockwise raise up and turn 90 degrees clockwise to secure them in the raised position.
- 6. Position yourself behind the seat and grasp it at each side at or below cushion level.
- 7. Push it forward and slightly to the left.
- 8. Rotate it anti clockwise until it is facing to the rear.
- 9. Adjust it into position (N.B. The seat does not lock in the 'camping' position to maintain safety so the vehicle is not driven while set this way)
- 10. Rotating the Seat to Face the Front
- 11. Repeat the above but rotate the seat in the clockwise direction.
- 12. Secure the seat with the four locking bolts, re-fit locating / security pins.
