Documentation - V5c.
Service history – very important on long-life service plans.
Factory recalls have been carried out.
MoT.
Outstanding finance / HPI clear.
Worn brake discs / pads (depending on mileage).
Wheels and tyres for damage and tread (depending on mileage).
Clutch judder / wear / high biting point (depending on mileage).
Dash warning lights / sensor issues. E.g., EGR sensor.
Coolant level (dropping means it could be leaking into cylinders / an EGR fault).
Engine – oil leaks, exhaust smoke, poor starting /running, abuse.
Leaking side windows.
Scratches / dents / faded or poor paint condition.
Take it for a test drive and note any faults.
If less than six years old, does it have a transferrable warranty?

Here's a good idea.

Once you have a rough idea of what needs replacing on a car, head here:

and tot up the likely cost of all the replacement parts you'll need. It will give you an indication of price and can be used as a bargaining tool with the seller.
