



VW T6 check list



- ☐ Documentation - V5c.
- ☐ Service history – very important on long-life service plans.
- ☐ Factory recalls have been carried out.
- ☐ MoT.
- ☐ Outstanding finance / HPI clear.
- ☐ Worn brake discs / pads (depending on mileage).
- ☐ Wheels and tyres for damage and tread (depending on mileage).
- ☐ Clutch judder / wear / high biting point (depending on mileage).
- ☐ Dash warning lights / sensor issues. E.g., EGR sensor.
- ☐ Coolant level (dropping means it could be leaking into cylinders / an EGR fault).
- ☐ Engine – oil leaks, exhaust smoke, poor starting /running, abuse.
- ☐ Leaking side windows.
- ☐ Scratches / dents / faded or poor paint condition.
- ☐ Take it for a test drive and note any faults.
- ☐ If less than six years old, does it have a transferrable warranty?

Here's a good idea.
